

# Maritime Radio Day

in commemoration to more than 100 years of maritime radio  
especially to operators on life saving duties



SCHEVENINGEN RADIO – PCH. Established on Dec. 19<sup>th</sup> 1904 for general maritime radio as part of the PTT. In 1951 the station moved in its entirety to Ijmuiden. In 1971 the station moved to new POST- RADIO premises in Ijmuiden. Services provided included Radio Telegraphy, Telephony, TOR (Telex over Radio) and VHF Radio. PCH was known for the excellent services provided and many international shipping companies used the station to communicate with their vessels. Due to the introduction of Satellite services in the 1980s traffic to Coast Stations declined rapidly and on December 31<sup>st</sup> 1998 at 4.00PM PCH sent its last message. The station is well remembered by radio officers for its strong signals across the Oceans and the fast and friendly service provided by its experienced staff.
